Muskegon Central Dispatch 9-1-1 Operating Millage Renewal
Shall the total constitutional tax rate limitation in the County of Muskegon be renewed the amount of up to .30 cents (\$.30) per one thousand dollars (\$1,000) (.30 mill) against all taxable property in the County of Muskegon for a period of 7 years beginning with December 1, 2023 levy and ending with the December 1, 2029 levy so as to provide funding for the operations of the 9-1-1 Central Dispatch? If approved and levied in its entirety on December 1, 2023, this millage would raise an estimated \$1,400,000 in the first year.

Shall the expired previously approved voted increase in the tax limitation under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Muskegon Charter Township be renewed at 1.5 mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for a period of five (5) years, 2022 through 2026 inclusive, for the purpose of Road Repair, Maintenance and Improvements; and if this millage is approved and levied in its entirety, the Township would collect an estimated \$623,000 in the first year of such levy?
