



Proposal 22-2



- Require military or overseas postmarked by election day; - Provide voter right to verify identity with photo ID or signed - Provide voter right to single application to vote absentee in absentee-ballot drop boxes, and - Provide that only election officials may conduct post-- Require nine days of early in-- Allow donations to fund - Require canvass boards certify election results based only on the official records of votes cast.


Proposal 22-3 A proposal to amend the state constitution to establish new individual right to reproductive freedom, including right to make all decisions about pregnancy and abortion; allow state to regulate abortion in some cases; and forbid prosecution of individuals exercising established right

This proposed constitutional amendment would:

- Establish new individual right to reproductive freedom, including right to make and carry out all decisions about pregnancy, such as prenatal care, childbirth, postpartum care, contraception, sterilization, abortion, miscarriage management, and infertility; - Allow state to regulate abortion after fetal viability, but not prohibit if medically needed to protect a patient's life or physical or mental health; - Forbid state discrimination in enforcement of this right; prohibit prosecution of an individual, or a person helping a pregnant individual, for exercising rights established by this amendment: - Invalidate state laws conflicting with this amendment.
