



This proposed constitutional amendment would: - Recognize fundamental right to vote without harassing - Require military or overseas ballots be counted if postmarked by election day; - Provide voter right to verify identity with photo ID or signed statement; - Provide voter right to single application to vote absentee in all elections: - Require state-funded absentee-ballot drop boxes, and postage for absentee applications and ballots; - Provide that only election officials may conduct postelection audits; - Require nine days of early inperson voting; - Allow donations to fund elections, which must be - Require canvass boards certify election results based only on the official records of votes cast. to reproductive freedom, including right to make and carry out all decisions about pregnancy, such as prenatal care, childbirth, postpartum care, contraception, sterilization, abortion, miscarriage management, and infertility; - Allow state to regulate abortion after fetal viability, but not prohibit if medically needed to protect a patient's life or physical or mental health; - Forbid state discrimination in enforcement of this right; prohibit prosecution of an individual, or a person helping a pregnant individual, for exercising rights established by this amendment: - Invalidate state laws conflicting with this amendment.
