Dutch artist Cyril Lixenberg based his career on the expressive potential of geometric forms. His large scale public works are found throughout West Michigan, including Grand Rapids, Grand Valley State University, and Holland. Lixenberg first came to Michigan in the 1980s, through a solo exhibition at the University of Michigan Museum of Art. He has exhibited on several occasions at the Muskegon Museum of Art, and his archives, including over 500 works on paper, are held by Grand Valley State University.
